This is who I am.


> This is how God made me.

Answer

Why does the Bible treat sex as *taboo*?

The Bible doesn't treat sex as taboo. It elevates it.

#### God created sex.

#### He encourages it.

Gen 1:27-28 So God created human beings in his own image. In the image of God he created them; male and female he created them. Then God blessed them and said, "Be fruitful and multiply."

1 Cor. 7:3-4 The husband should fulfill his wife's sexual needs, and the wife should fulfill her husband's needs. The wife gives authority over her body to her husband, and the husband gives authority over his body to his wife.

#### Genesis 2:24-25

Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh. And the man and his wife were both naked and were not ashamed.



**Does the Bible say** sexual feelings are wrong?

Your ability to feel was given you by God including your sexual feelings.

Gen 1:31 **Then God looked** over all he had made, and he saw that it was very good!

A husband and wife having feelings for each other is beautiful.

Song of Solomon 1:7 I belong to my beloved, and his desire is for me. **But there can** be a warping of something **God intended** as a gift.

Heb. 13:4 Give honor to marriage, and remain faithful to one another in marriage. God will surely judge people who are immoral and those who commit adultery.

or are abusive, or cheat peoplenone of these will inherit the Kingdom of God. <sup>11</sup> Some of you were once like that. But you were cleansed; you were made holy; you were made right with God by calling on the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God . . .

**1 Cor 6** 

But you can't say that our bodies were made for sexual immorality. They were made for the Lord, and the Lord cares about our bodies. <sup>14</sup> And God will raise us from the dead by his power, just as he raised our Lord from the dead. <sup>15</sup> Don't you realize that your bodies are actually parts

#### **1 Cor 6**

**Of Christ? Should a man take his** body, which is part of Christ, and join it to a prostitute? Never! <sup>16</sup> And don't you realize that if a man joins himself to a prostitute, he becomes one body with her? For the Scriptures say, "The two are united into one." 17 But the person who is joined to the Lord

#### **1 Cor 6**

is one spirit with him. <sup>18</sup> Run from sexual sin! No other sin so clearly affects the body as this one does. For sexual immorality is a sin against your own body. <sup>19</sup> Don't you realize that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and

was given to you by God? You do not belong to yourself, <sup>20</sup> for God bought you with a high price. So you must honor God with your body.

# Why is Jesus quiet about homosexuality?

Jesus does address sex and marriage Mark 10

<sup>2</sup> Some Pharisees came and tried to trap him with this question: "Should a man be allowed to divorce his wife?" <sup>3</sup> Jesus answered them with a question: "What did Moses say in the law about divorce?"

Points to Law **Speaks** with authority Points to an ideal

<sup>4</sup> "Well, he permitted it," they replied. "He said a man can give his wife a written notice of divorce and send her away." <sup>5</sup> But Jesus responded, "He wrote this commandment only as a concession to your hard hearts. <sup>6</sup> But

'God made them male and female' from the beginning of creation. <sup>7</sup> 'This explains why a man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, <sup>8</sup> and the two are united into one.' Since they are no longer

Jesus didn't restate the Law to those who knew it Lev. 18-20
